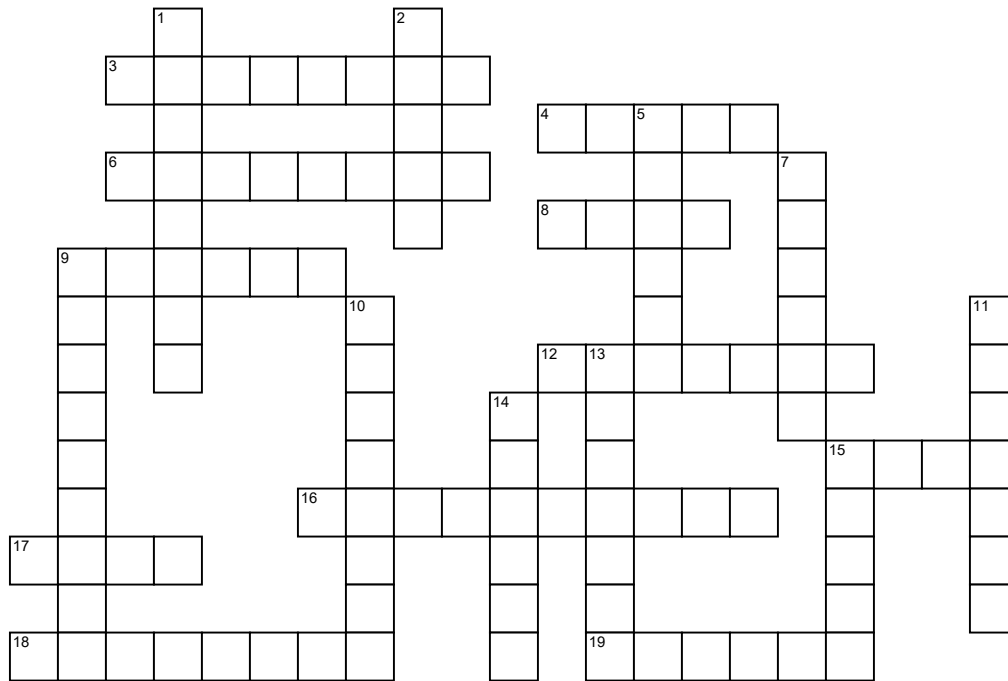


# The Beginning of Acts

### ACROSS
